**Scholarship Rules:**

2. The scholarship application must be filled out in its entirety.
3. The service portion area is to be used to chronologically timeline only your parish and community activities starting with the most recent. When specifying dates (just providing a month and year will suffice), give a detailed description of the function along with the duration of the service.
4. The service portion can be handwritten (neatness counts) or computer-generated.
5. The applicant's name must be written on the back side of the service sheet and last page of the application.
6. Applications are available on the Council's website [www.council12788.org](http://www.council12788.org), which can be filled out electronically and then printed for submission. Applications are also located in the church pamphlet racks or St. Joseph's School and Parish Office.
7. The application must be delivered to the Council's mailbox by the church office closing on **October 31, 2017. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

There will be three categories being scored: the quality of the application, parish activities, and community activities. The student with the highest score will be awarded the scholarship. In case of a tie score, the award will be divided equally between the two students. Students who are sons/daughters of Council #12788 Knights/Columbiettes or are Squires/Squirettes will receive 5 bonus points.
