Dick had a young family and wanted to spend time with them and I married and wanted to be the best I could be for my wife. I always knew Dick belonged to the Knights of Columbus in Middletown, but never knew he belonged to our Assembly until I was doing a newsletter several months ago and I was looking up members birthdays and found Dick's birthday for that month. Just knowing that my friend, who I depended on in so many situations in the fire service had been a Sir Knight for many years sent a calming sensation over me.
